## CHILD CARE CENTER PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

In order to obtain a child care facility license, interested individuals must attend an orientation. Orientations are scheduled at the local regional offices on a regular basis, statewide, or individuals may participate in an <u>online orientation</u> at: (https://secure1.cpshr.us/CDSSv2/RegistrationForm?i=019a06de-6c80-4da1-b00d-bda0404fa53c). There is an orientation fee and it is nonrefundable.

Licensed child care facilities are required to pay an annual licensing fee, as well as other fees such as for a change in location, change in capacity, and change in corporate status; and late fees, probation fees, and dishonored check fees.
